At each WWRF meeting, we will be making an award to the author of the best paper based on a contribution made to that meeting

Award Rules

- All papers must be submitted by the full paper deadline for the conference
- Papers must be based on an abstract submitted to and accepted by the programme committee, and the paper must have been presented in the conference
- The paper must be a full-length paper that has not been published elsewhere, must comply with WWRF template and be accompanied by a signed WWRF copyright form
- WWRF Working Group chairs will recommend the best papers from the contributions submitted to their groups
- The Awards Committee will review all eligible papers, and decide upon the winner and runner up
- There will be prize of €500 for the winner and €250 for the runner up as well as a certificate
- If no paper of sufficient quality is submitted, then no award will be made.
- The Award will be presented on the last day of the corresponding WWRF meeting
